Common Uses:

General surgical procedures

Properties:

- Common Length: 5 1/2in - 9in
- Beveled blades

Variations:

- Blade: Straight and Curved
- Stainless steel and titanium

Function:

Straight-bladed Mayo scissors are designed for cutting body tissues near the surface of a wound. Curved-bladed Mayo scissors allow deeper penetration into the wound than the type with straight blades. The curved style of Mayo scissor is used to cut thick tissues.

Did you know?



Mayo scissors have semi-blunt ends, a feature that distinguishes them from most other surgical scissors.
