Function:

It is a heavy-duty surgical instrument used for gouging out bone. It can also be used to open a window in bone, often in the skull, in order to access tissue underneath.

Kerrison Rongeurs are the most difficult instrument to decontaminate and clean in a neuro-surgical case.
