Common Uses:

General Surgical procedures

Properties:

- Mildly tapered tip
- Serrated

Function:

Widely used in general surgery to hold and manipulate curved needles. Most needle holders have a clamp mechanism that locks the needle in place, allowing the user to maneuver the needle through various tissues.

Variations:

- Heavy / Delicate
- Left Handed / Right Handed
- TC / Titanium
