Common Uses:

General, Plastic, Ortho Surgeries

Properties:

- 5/8" (1.5cm) width blades
- Double ended, round tips
- Right angle

Variations:

- Stainless steel or titanium

Function:

An Army Navy retractor (other names: USA, US Army) is used to retract shallow or superficial incisions for various procedures from small wounds to abdominal operations

Did you know?



It is commonly believed that Navy is the long side of the retractor because they go deeper, whereas Army side is the short one because Army always gets the short end of the stick.
