## Scissor Metzenbaum Curved, B/B, 7in

### Common Uses:

Used across the board for cutting delicate tissue and blunt dissection.

### Properties:

- Variable Lengths: 5 3/4in - 14in
- Blades: Curved or Straight
- Tips: Blunt or Sharp

### Variations:

- Stainless Steel, TC, Super Cut, Delicate, Serrated/Smooth

### Function:

They are described as “useful for any operation where a keen cutting, blunt-pointed dissecting scissors is desired [as] the blades of the scissors are thin, slightly tapering, with blunt points, and when closed form an excellent dry dissector.”

Did you know?



The Metzenbaum is the most common type of scissor used in organ operations.
