Bonney Tissue Forceps are made for holding thick tissues such as fascia. This instrument will provide the atraumatic tissue grasping ability during dissection.

Dr. Bonney was a gynecologist who performed 500 radical hysterectomies for cervical cancer and invented auxiliary hysterectomy forceps, vascular forceps, tissue forceps, and other devices which reduced the complications and mortality rate
